The Landsail Tyre Life Guarantee provides full peace of mind that you will get value from your Landsail tyres throughout the life of the tyre.

## The guarantee

We will replace any tyre that is found to be defective due to the manufacturing process or the materials used.

We will replace any tyre with irreparable damage resulting from normal road use.

## How to make a claim

To make a Tyre Life Guarantee Claim, simply return the tyre to the Landsail dealer it was purchased from. The dealer will replace the tyre at a discounted price based on the amount of tread remaining on the tyre.

Discount is applied on the following scale:

Landsail Tyre Life Guarantee discount scale	
Remaining Tread	Replacement Discount
7mm and above	100% Allowance
Between 7mm and 6mm	75% Allowance
Between 6mm and 4mm	50% Allowance
Between 4mm and 2mm	25% Allowance
Below 2mm	Nil Allowance

## Guarantee exclusions

The guarantee covers material or manufacturing defects, and irreparable damage caused by normal road use. It excludes damaged caused by the following:

- A mechanical defect in the vehicle
- Use of unsuitable wheels
- Not maintaining correct tyre pressure
- Carrying or towing loads in excess of vehicle specification
- Improper or prolonged use of snow chains
- Competition use
- Removal of a wheel or poor fitting of the tyre
- Acts of God, malicious damage, vandalism, fire, or theft
- Road traffic accident damage or ensuing problems
- Use of tyre that doesn't match the vehicle specification
- Prolonged contact with acids, solvents or oils

## Tyre safety

Inspect your tyres regularly for visible signs of damage, such as cuts or bulges in the sidewall or uneven wear. Have any damage checked by your tyre retailer as soon as possible.

Landsail recommend the following key areas should be checked to ensure that your tyres continue to perform safely and efficiently.

## Tread depth

All tread depths including the spare must be greater than the legal minimum of 1.6mm in a continuous band throughout the central  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the tread width, and across the entire circumference of the tyre.

Grip diminishes progressively with wear and as a consequence stopping distances increase, especially in the wet.

## Tyre pressure

Tyre pressures should be checked regularly, and always when the tyre is cold.

Low tyre pressure can lead to:

- Structural damage due to overheating
- Increased vehicle fuel consumption
- Reduction in grip
- Irregular & premature wear of the tyre shoulder areas

Excessive tyre pressure can lead to:

- Increased chance of blowout
- Excessive wear on the centre of the tread
- Less comfortable driving experience

## Tracking and alignment

Tracking and wheel alignment should be checked at regular intervals. Poor alignment and tracking causes irregular and rapid tyre wear resulting in the need to replace tyres more frequently.

Inspect your tyres regularly for visible signs of damage, such as cuts or bulges in the sidewall or uneven wear. Have any damage checked by your tyre retailer as soon as possible.
